

WORKS OF MERCY

Praying for the sick and dying and those without hope.

Every third Friday of the month a prayer vigil is maintained to pray for the sick, the dying, family, peace and those without hope. This is a one hour vigil held from 3-4pm during the 24hr Adoration of the Blessed Eucharist conducted at Christ the King Parish in Burnside, Christchurch. It is held in either the main church or the small oratory at the rear of the church. The Chaplet of Mercy and Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary are prayed along with selected prayers from the Diary of St Faustina together with reflections on mercy and silent time.

There is also a First Class Relic of St Faustina present at all vigils and this is available for all who have prayer requests to make through the intercession of St Faustina. Please consider joining our group to implore mercy for the whole world.
